

## GOVERNMENT NOTICE

## The Kingdom of Morocco Scholarships 2017

The Government of the Kingdom of Morocco is inviting applications from Barbadian students who wish to pursue studies in higher, vocational or professional education at Moroccan Institutions for the academic year commencing September 2017.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

- Applicants must be Citizens of Barbados.
- Applicants interested in pursuing undergraduate studies must be between the age of 19 and 23 years.
- Applicants interested in pursuing a Master's degree must hold a Bachelor's degree with at least Lower 2<sup>nd</sup> Class honours.
- Applicants interested in pursuing a Doctoral degree must be the holder of a Master's degree.

Successful applicants must be fluent in French.

Applicants are required to submit a fully completed application form accompanied by the following documents:

- 1 A certified copy of the certificate of matriculation;
- 2 Two (2) certified copies of the transcript of the baccalaureate;
- 3 Two (2) certified copies of the birth certificate;
- 4 A recent Police record;
- 5 Two (2) certified copies of the passport; and

6 A recent medical certificate issued by the Public Health Services showing the physical aptitude of the applicant and certifying that he/she is vaccinated and not suffering from any contagious illness or carrying any pandemic disease.

Candidates for the Master's and PhD must provide, in addition to the above documents, copies of degrees of higher education, certified copies of transcripts and a copy of dissertation/thesis of graduation/draft thesis.
