The 2018 Japan Exchange and Teaching (JET) Programme

Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons for the 2018 Japan Exchange and Teaching (JET) programme.

AIM

The aim of the JET Programme is to enhance foreign language education and promote international exchange at the local level through the fostering of the ties between Japanese youth and foreign youth.

The Programme offers participants the opportunity to serve in local authorities as well as public and private elementary, junior high, and senior high schools in Japan.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must:

- be citizens of Barbados and possess a university degree, preferably English Language, Linguistics or Education.
- have a strong command of English, with excellent pronunciation, intonation and voice projection skills.
- have an interest in the Japanese educational system.

Teaching experience would be an asset.

DETAILS

Applicants may apply for the post of Assistant Language Teacher (ALT). The participants will be engaged in language instruction and will be placed mainly in local boards of education, elementary, junior high and senior high schools.

The ability to speak Japanese is **not** a requirement, but efforts to study or continue studying Japanese prior to and after arriving in Japan will be given additional consideration.

The deadline for the application is **Friday, November 10, 2017.**
